34/26. ITEMS RAISED BY MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

36/26 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.

Street scene Grids by the square need clearing of weeds.

Litter on S. Bends. It has been noted that there are an abundance of Costa containers thrown on the edges.

Reminder of request for a bin on opposite side of bus top near Tweedmill.

Cllr. Ellis advised that the warning marker on Pont Rhedyn had been replaced. This appears to be as a result of a member of the public complaining. The members expressed disappointment that DCC had appeared to ignore the TCC despite numerous reminders.

Breach of CL. Cllr. Elson has been in touch with Paul Griffin. The previous enforcement notice issued has generated a planning application which cancels the enforcement notice. The notice had expired which triggered the application. Cllr. Elson has searched the planning portal and there does not appear to be a live application at present. Cllr. Elson will continue to push the issue.

The priority is to address the presence of caravans which appear to be residential along with double decker buses on the fields. Overall the site requires tidying up.

LLANNERCH BRIDGE. Cllr. Elson has no further update. He is presently trying to find someone within Welsh Water to facilitate discussion around a Bailey Bridge. Members expressed concern regarding a planting of hedging in front of the damaged bridge suggesting a permanent closure.

Defibrillator. Clarification needed regarding expiry dates of pad supplied with unit.
