16/26 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.

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6. Breach of CL. Cllr. Elson advised he had not had any response from the Enforcement Office. He confirmed a retrospective planning application had been submitted.
7. Llannerch Bridge. Cllr. Elson advised that he is still researching possible funding avenues but costings of project are needed first. A financial underspend has had to be returned to Cardiff. A manufacturing company has confirmed that a suitable bridge would have a lifespan of around 50 years. He is frustrated about the lack of response to his emails to Dcc.
